Cedar House on Sound offers comfort, relaxation and fine wine

Mattituck, New York, March 15, 2011. . . Visitors to Long Island’s burgeoning wine country can now enjoy the comforts of home while sampling the wares of the region’s over three dozen wineries. The newly opened Cedar House on Sound Bed & Breakfast is owned and operated by the proprietors of Scarola Vineyards, one of Long Island’s up-and-coming wine producers. Located in Mattituck on the North Fork – the heart of Long Island’s wine scene – the spacious B&B is a former potato packing barn that’s been lovingly rebuilt from the ground up, using the barn’s original wood for ceiling beams, window trim and other architectural elements.

Cedar House boasts five distinctive guest rooms, an expansive great room (with a 52” flat-screen TV and regulation-size billiards table), a spacious dining room and an inviting guest lounge, all surrounded by acres of open, pristine countryside. Frank and Donna Scarola and their cousins David and Donna Perrin, the innkeepers at Cedar House, have created an environment that is both fresh and contemporary and completely in tune with the area’s rustic beauty. Their B&B features polished hardwood floors, local art, unique amenities, and furniture and fixtures reflecting the colors and forms of Tuscany. (The Scarola family immigrated to America from Italy during the mid-20th century.) Appropriately, the Scarolas are planting a vineyard on the property this spring.

“Our goal with Cedar House is to marry the North Fork’s agricultural traditions to the concept of the Italian *masseria*, or small family farm, which is an integral part of our family’s heritage,” says Frank Scarola, whose first commercial wines date to the 2002 vintage. “Our aim is to take wine country hospitality to the next level and provide our guests with the perfect getaway destination.”

The Perrins are the perfect couple to help accomplish that goal. Veteran hospitality professionals, they’re dedicated to providing each and every Cedar House guest with the optimum in comfort and relaxation, which, not surprisingly, includes wine tasting.

Tasting of Scarola Vineyards wines at Cedar House is complimentary and takes place in the inn’s Vineyard Lounge, a paean to North Fork viticulture that opens onto a sunny south-facing patio and the soon-to-be-planted vineyard. Because the Perrins are wine and hospitality experts, their guests are guaranteed an entertaining and informative wine tasting experience.
